We are excited to share with you new developments in our garden and food program. After many successful years of offering a strong garden program, we have made some significant progress towards creating a solid food program.

- Construction on our edible roof garden and ecoroof began this summer thanks in part to generous auction gifts from our community.
- We received a Portland Development Commission Grant for over \$33,000 to continue to build our scratch commercial community kitchen and construction will happen this summer.
- We have contracted with a new vendor to offer fresh, organic, and vegetarian and vegan, locally and sustainably grown and prepared, breakfast and lunches. We will no longer be using disposable dishes and students will be active in helping with the program.

DETAILS:

- We will continue to participate in the federal free/reduced lunch program with no changes for those who complete the application and qualify.
- Punch cards will still be available at the front desk.
- Purchased breakfasts will remain at \$1.40 and lunches will be \$3.00.
- Meals will be served family style and portions will be appropriate for the various ages.
