Trillium Charter School is a constructivist, mixed-age learning environment. Our curriculum requires that students be able to work both independently and cooperatively in groups. Students are required to be willing participants in their own education and to take the responsibility of their own learning seriously. Students are required to participate in Trillium's Democratic Governing system. Parents are required to support their students in a variety of ways, including but not limited to ensuring their students attend school on a regular basis, arrive on time and ready to learn, come prepared for all scheduled off campus activities and attend all required parent student conferences and scheduled class and teacher meetings.

While Trillium offers many experiences outside the public school norm, we also lack some services. We do not have a Student Management specialist to handle discipline issues, nor a vice principal. However, we do have Special Education assistance provided from the PPS district. We are able to provide transportation on existing district bus routes and we do provide free/reduced lunch (not breakfast) for those qualifying and hope to have our own lunch program in the future.
