

## MIDDLE SCHOOL OFF-CAMPUS PERMISSION FORM

Trillium Charter School is implementing off-campus privileges for middle school students the staff believes are ready for the added responsibility. Parents or guardians must give permission below. Students are permitted off-campus only with at least one more person. They must sign in and out each time they leave campus. Privileges can be revoked for failure to follow these procedures, as well as other behaviors demonstrated at school that bring into question their level of readiness for this responsibility.

Students must show a level of responsibility to the community as well, and must not litter, vandalize, or interfere with the community in a negative manner. Students must be in good academic standing in order to be granted this privilege. Failure to maintain good academic standing will result in termination of these privileges. Students must return on time for class while off campus.

Parents agree, by signing this permission form that, the student is not under the supervision of the school while off campus, and that Trillium is not responsible for the safety or behavior of the student while off campus.

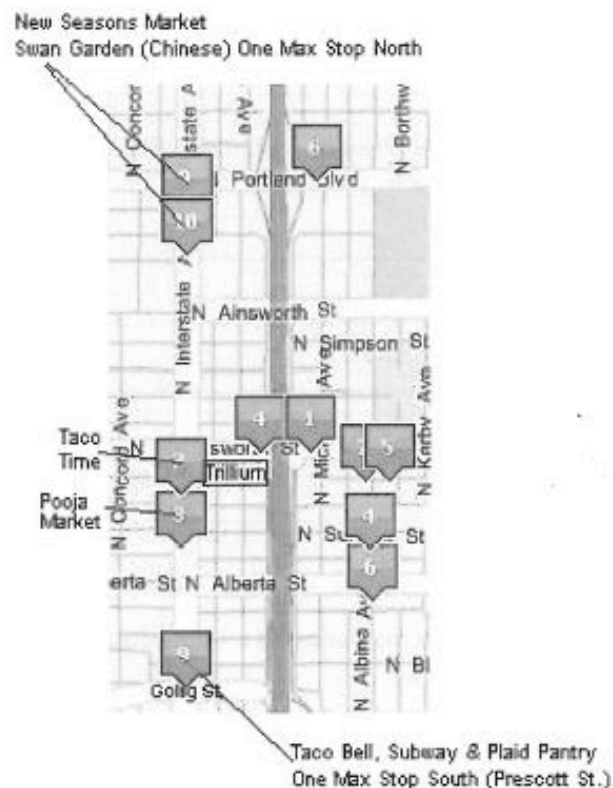

- Reflects on personal decisions/choices regarding health and nutrition issues.
