About Trillium Charter School

Trillium is a K-12 Public Charter School in North Portland, Oregon. Trillium students are actively involved learners in building personal knowledge of the world around them through action, experience, and reflection. Trillium’s education philosophy centers on contextual teaching/learning and constructivism. We utilize a relationship-based model that focuses on problem solving, project-oriented, and collaborative learning. Students engage as active participants in their learning and develop their own meaning and knowledge in the process. Equity, social justice and community are at the foundation of our education model and are woven into our curricula.

Position Overview

High School teachers at Trillium serve a dual role of teaching academic core subjects to all high school-aged students, as well as serving as an academic advisor for approximately 17 high school students. The high school Math teacher is responsible for all math instruction for students in 9-12th grades. The teacher also serves to support the “foundations cohort (9th grade students)”, orient to Trillium High School and learn about proficiency.

All teachers in our school serve on one of five committees. Teachers are supported through frequent meetings with the high school team, upper school team, committees, all staff meetings and critical friend’s professional learning communities. We offer training and support in restorative justice, democratic education, classroom management, proficiency, professional learning communities and others as needs arise.

All full time employees at Trillium have access to medical and dental insurance as well as reduced rates for childcare. All employees are enrolled in the Public Employee Retirement System (PERS).

A successful High School Math Teacher will:

- Design and implement curriculum for Integrated Math classes, Geometry, Algebra 2, Applies Math and Pre- Calculus
- Prepare students for formal assessments to meet Essential Skills requirements including preparation for Smarter Balance state assessments, as well as complaining and assessing work samples.
- Serve as an academic advisor for approximately 17 students, including tracking credits, analyzing transcripts, offering social/emotional support, and serving as community touchstone for student and family.
- Help to support one of four cohorts of student's n: high school orientation/proficiency assessment, leadership, internship *or* senior thesis/project.
- Participate in collaborative leadership structure through high school team, upper school and all staff meetings.
- Serve on one of five committees in monthly meetings. Committees include leadership, teaching & learning, equity, student support and operations.
- Manage student information through Synergy electronic database. Includes daily attendance and grade tracking.
- Facilitate student-led conferences.
- Offer a differentiated curriculum that creates learning and assessment opportunities for a wide range of ability levels.
- Approach problems with flexibility, creativity, collaboration and critical thinking.
- Is available during school hours 8:00 AM until 4:30 PM Monday-Friday
